By-Laws Chapter B, Art VI, Sec. 9. Committee of Investigation.

A petition for degrees, affiliation or re-instatement when received by Chapter shall immediately be referred to an Investigating Committee consisting of (3) members, one of whom shall be a man. Upon a petition for degrees, it shall be the duty of the committee to inquire into the character, fitness and Masonic standing or relationship to the petitioner. When the place of residence of the petitioner is different from the location of the Chapter, the committee shall ascertain the reason. Upon a petition for affiliation or re-instatement the committee is also charged with the duty of verifying former or present membership in the Order as well as fitness of character. The names of the Committee shall be recorded in the minutes. A petition which has been received and referred to a committee cannot be withdrawn but must be balloted on for final decision.

A written report either favorable or unfavorable shall be made by at least a majority of the committee, one of whom shall be a man. The nature of the report shall be announced but shall not be recorded in the minutes.

A Chapter may provide in its By-Laws for a standing Committee of Investigation. This standing committee may assist, but shall not displace, the regular Committee of Investigation, and it shall not report to the Chapter.
